YOU DON'T HAVE TO FIND A BUS STOP SIGN TO CATCH A TTA BUS.

TTA buses stop at most street corners and along the roads and by ways. Just a friendly wave or a small step toward the curb will bring the bus to a stop.

Paying your fare is easy with TTA's electronic fareboxes.

TTA "DIAL A RIDE" IS FOR RIDERS WITH A DISABILITY THAT KEEPS THEM FROM TAKING THE BUS.
