

Proposed removable floodwall at Harris Riverfront Park

The city is considering replacing the concrete floodwall sections between the 10th and 12th street entrances to Harris Riverfront Park with a removable floodwall. The removable barrier is erected only when floodwaters reach threatening levels. Advocates say it will bring more attention to the park and help connect downtown businesses to the riverfront.
